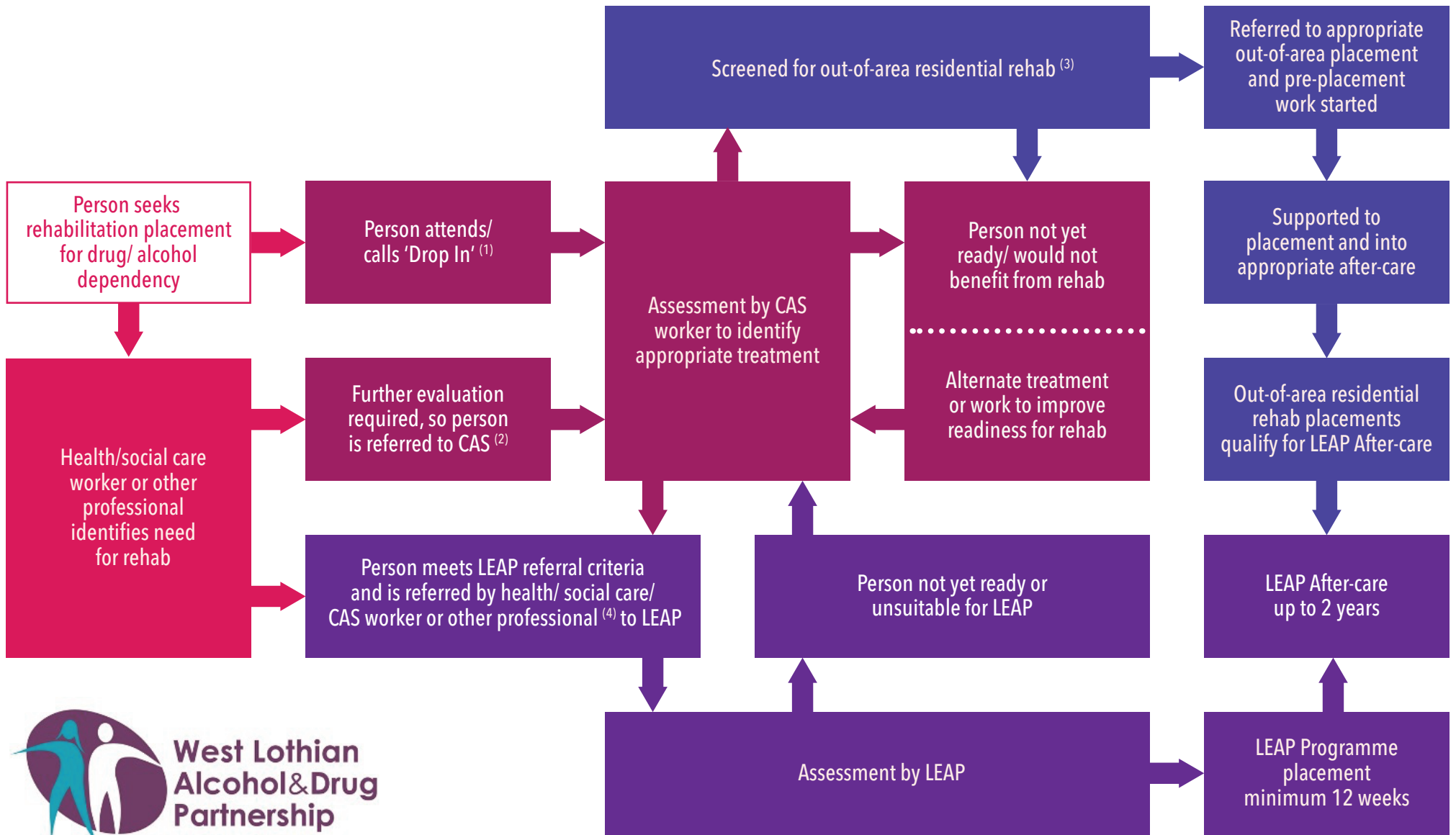

RESIDENTIAL REHAB PATHWAY NOTES (WEST LOTHIAN)

- (1) Drop-ins are provided at different sites across West Lothian over Monday to Friday and are advertised widely.
- (2) CAS is the West Lothian HSCP Community Addictions Service and a comprises 2 aligned teams: one of nurses, OTs, psychiatrists, psychologist and health care support workers; working alongside a team of social workers and addiction workers; and is supported by Referrals may come from third sector addictions services, GPs or other health or social care teams and self-referrals.
- (3) Screening for out-of-area residential rehabilitation is by a group of senior multi-disciplinary workers who assess the assessment to ensure that a placement is required and likely to be effective and to determine to which placement the person should be referred.
- (4) e.g., CPN, GP, consultant, voluntary sector, criminal justice, homelessness, learning disability or mental health services to single point of referral at LEAP using SCI Gateway (GPs) or the LEAP Referral Form which can be downloaded from LEAP website:

Referrals can be received through any service within the Addictions Partnership (CAS, WLDAS and CGL) and are discussed at the Addictions Partnership meeting every Mon, Wed and Friday. Referrals send to CAS come through SCI Gateway or the NHS clinical mailbox (addictions.service@nhslothian.scot.nhs.uk) or Social Work mailbox (socialworkaddictionsteam@westlothian.gov.uk).
